




This crucifix was a religious inspiration for Vincent Cheng. Together with a paper candle made from a toilet roll, they symbolised sacrifice and victory.


















Vincent Cheng studied the whole book and practised the techniques on himself. It eventually led to his interest in natural health therapies.






Hospital Mata

Hospital Mata Tun Hussein Onn yang dibangunkan dengan perbelanjaan lebih sepuluh juta ringgit memang mencatat sejarah perubatan negara. Hospital ini adalah hospital mata yang ulung dan yang pertama di Malaysia dan juga ASEAN. Ia mengadakan perkhidmatan mencegah kerosakan mata untuk masyarakat umum tanpa mengambil apa-apa keuntungan serta mengadakan rawatan perubatan dan pembedahan untuk penyakit mata. Ia juga mengadakan kemudahan latihan kakitangan dan mengadakan kemudahan penyelidikan mengenai penyakit mata. Kemudahan, serta perkhidmatan hospital mata dinikmati oleh semua rakyat Malaysia serta negara-negara ASEAN.

Hospital Mata Tun Hussein Onn pasti akan menjadi sebuah badan kebajikan kerana keseluruhan kos pembinaan hospital mata ini adalah hasil sumbangan serta derma yayasan, pertubuhan sukarela, syarikat-syarikat swasta dan orang-orang perseorangan. 




